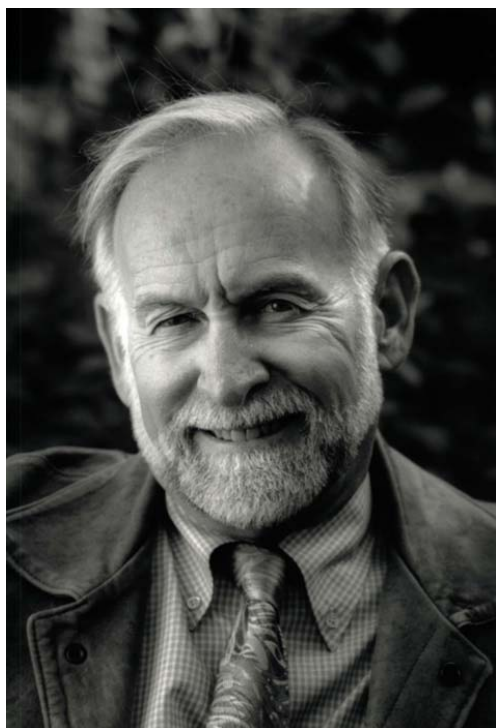


Royal Robbins: “40 Years of Adventure: First Ascents and First Descents”

Royal Robbins is one of the most influential American rock climbers of the twentieth century. With first ascents in Yosemite and Europe in the 1960s and 70s, he defined a new era of mountaineering. Since then, Robbins has made over 30 first descents of rivers in California, Chile, Norway and Russia and was named a “paddler of the century” by Paddler Magazine.
